CAREER SERVICES HIGHLIGHTS

Career Services helps students land their dream jobs after graduation by preparing them with interview skills, polishing their resumes and connecting them with employers through career fairs and networking opportunities.

MSOE students are in demand. Our Fall 2019 Career Fair had a record high turnout with 338 employers in attendance, resulting in a 1:8 employer to student ratio. Our competitors have substantially higher ratios, ranging from 22–71 students per employer. At MSOE, we provide more opportunities for students to connect and have meaningful conversations with employers.

New this year, we developed a Peer Coaching Program where students receive one-on-one coaching from their peers to prepare for interviews.
